Dear Parents/Carers,

Children can sometimes feel unwell at school and ask for paracetamol. Under new regulations we are not allowed to administer paracetamol without parental consent.

Please note paracetamol will only be handed out between the hours of 12.40pm and 1.40pm and not during lessons or any other break times.

If you are agreeable to us providing your child with paracetamol on request (a maximum of 2 tablets per day for the relief of minor ailments such as toothache headaches not associated with a blow to the head, painful periods, and sore throats) please would you sign and return the slip at the foot of the page. We will then compile a register and provide paracetamol where parental consent has been given.

If a child or young person makes repeated requests for paracetamol, the school may withdraw the availability of the medication, even if parents have returned written consent.
