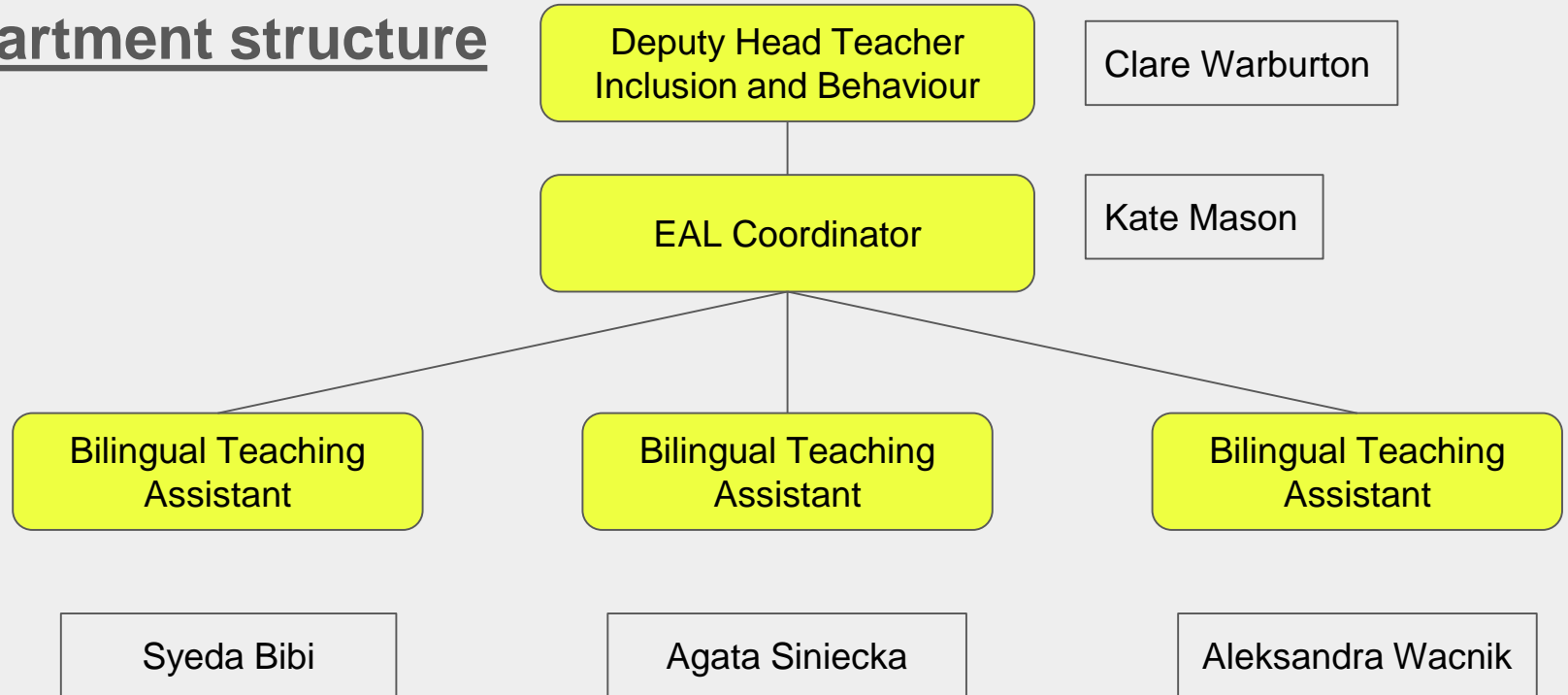


Meet the EAL Department at Biddenham

Miss Syeda

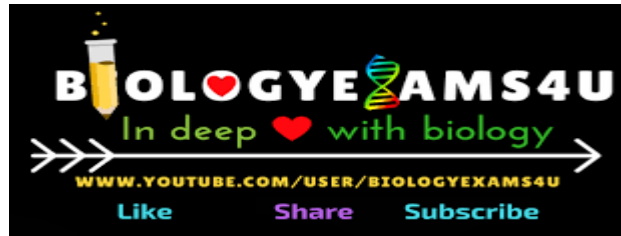
I speak English, Bengali and some Urdu.

I am good at making friends and enjoy socialising. I enjoy helping children

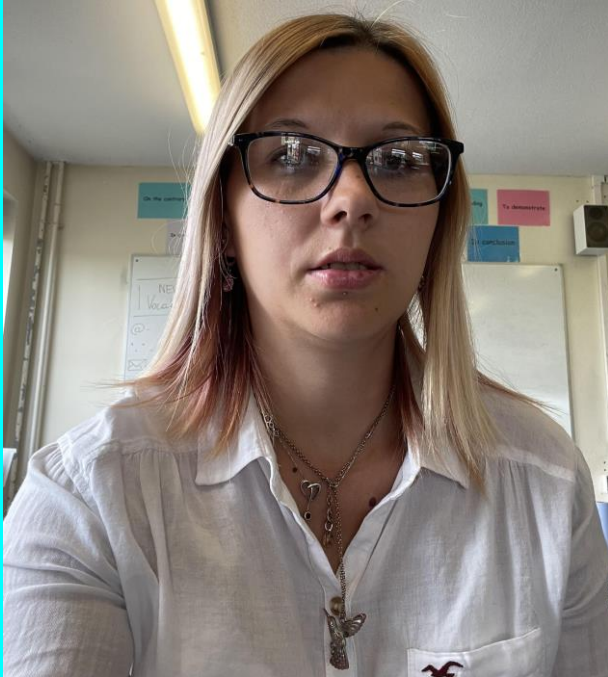
I need to improve being organised and making time for myself.

I am good at planning trips and days out . I'm also good at making friends, interacting with others and I love meeting new people. I'm always happy to help!



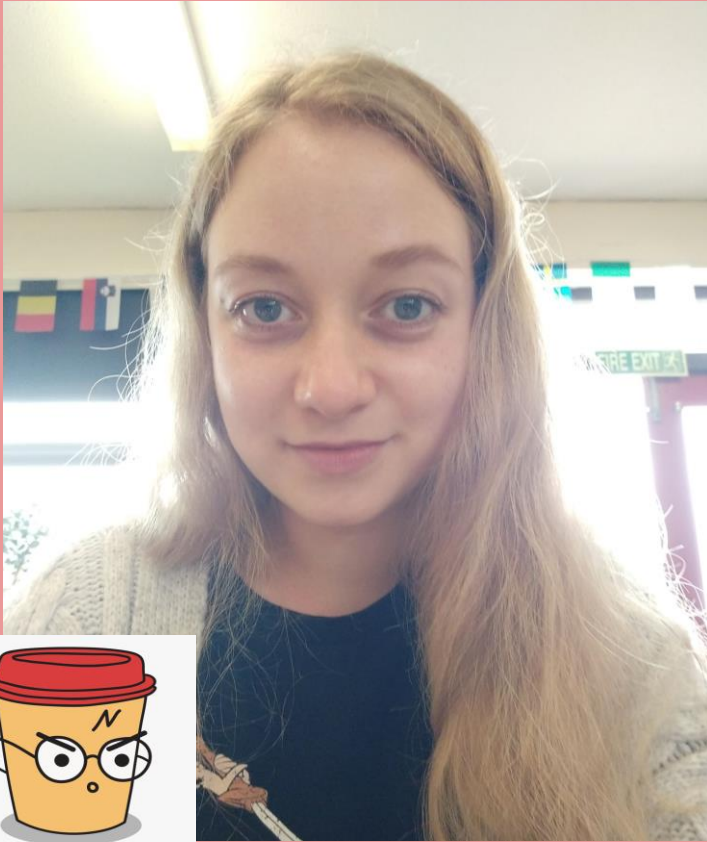
I am proud of my kids :)
