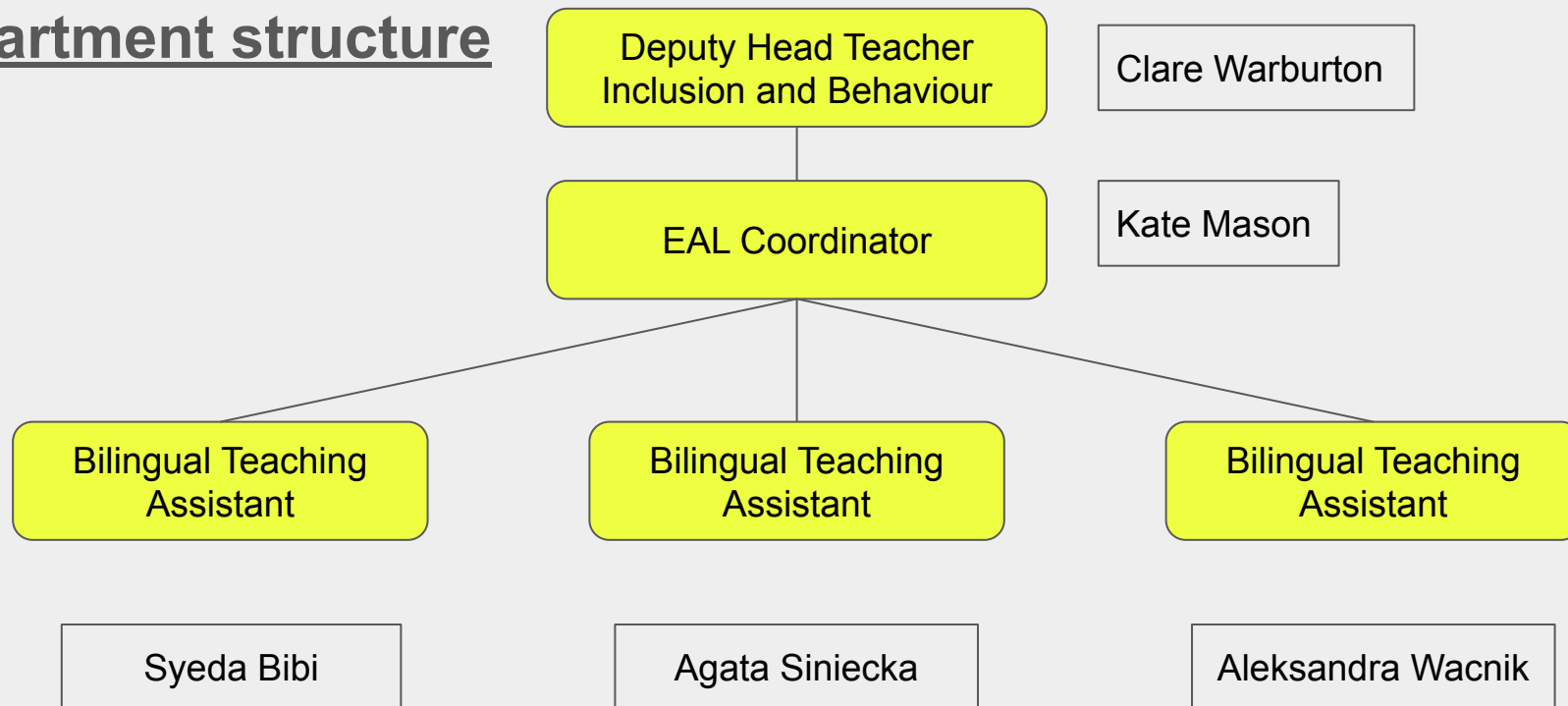

## Department structure



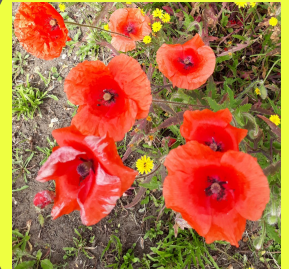
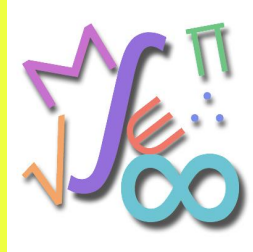
# Hello, I'm Mrs Mason

I enjoy working at Biddenham meeting students from all over the world and their families.

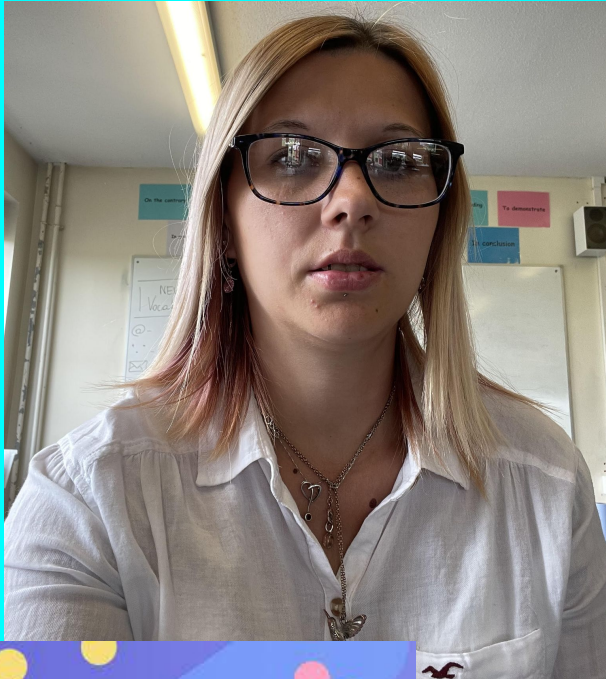
I love my 'pirate' cat, my 'rescue' chickens, being in my garden and coffee.
