A few minutes after jesus got hanged his shoulders dislocated




When you get crucified you are tied or nailed to a big wooden beam and you are left there until you slowly die from exhaustion

On a cross you could not last more than 24 hours the most.



## The Punishment of Crucifixion

Crucifixion was a method of punishment in which the victim was either nailed or tied to a large wooden beam in the shape of a cross, they would be left there till eventual death. This was a method of punishment that was mainly used by the Romans.











When the victim arrived at the place of crucifixion, he would be stripped naked to further shame.
