



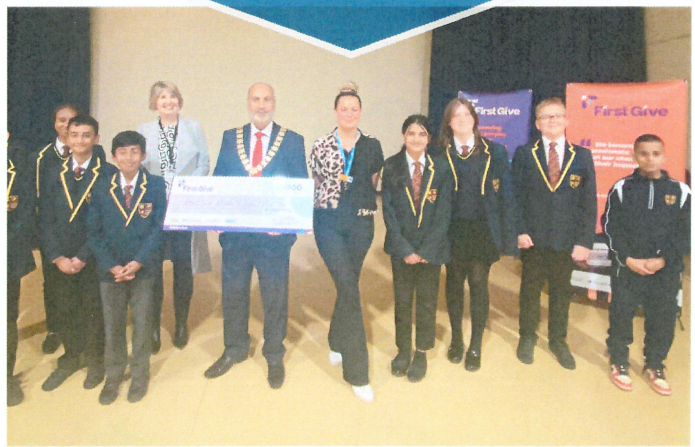

May Half term '23

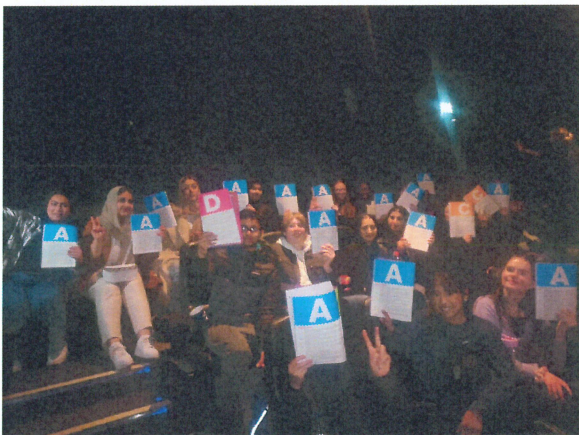


Five Y12 students were given an exciting opportunity to attend a live seminar at the PwC office in Embankment.

Six of our **Y10** students enjoyed attending a STEM day at Redborne as part of the Wadham Project"



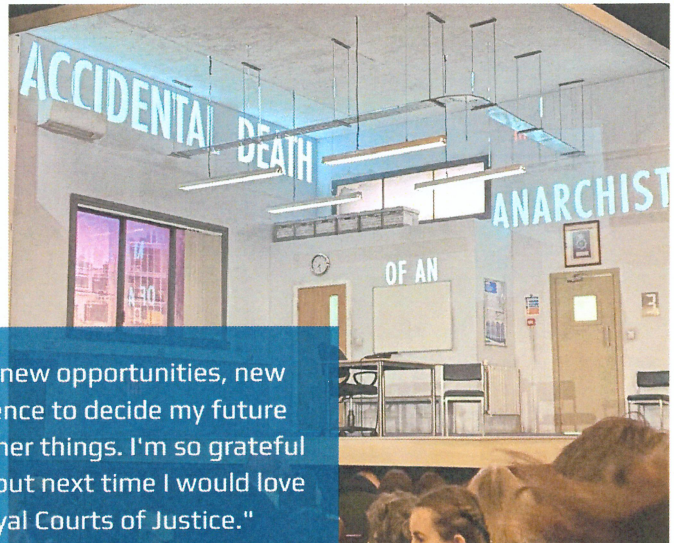
