








STUDENT BEHAVIOUR POLICY

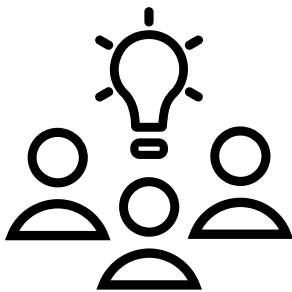
READY, RESPECT, REWARD

At Biddenham, we want everyone to feel safe, respected and be ready to learn. This means that students and staff need to work together to create a positive and caring environment. When people behave well, it helps everyone learn better.








We will achieve this by:

-  Creating a safe and friendly environment in school where everyone is ready to learn
-  Ensuring everyone is treated with respect
-  Having a consistent approach to managing behaviour
-  Focusing on rewarding good behaviour and helping students learn from their mistakes
-  Teaching each student to take responsibility for their own behaviour and actions






If someone behaves inappropriately we have strategies in place to help. However, if our school expectations around our positive and caring environment are not met, further action will need to be taken.



The next steps could include:

-  Getting a verbal warning from a teacher
-  Participating in restorative practices
-  Having a phone call or letter sent home
-  Being assigned a detention
-  Spending time in the Inclusion Room (IR)
-  Meeting with home to discuss behaviour
-  Being suspended from school

Making the right choices will be rewarded by:

-  House points that can be exchanged on classcharts for prizes
-  Postcards home
-  Positive phonecalls home
-  Invitation to end of term year group rewards
-  Special privileges
