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
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# Alastair Campbell's Visit






All students received a signed copy of his new book 'But What Can I Do?' filled with practical advice and motivational tips on campaigning for systemic change.


**Students visited the National Museum** of Computing, Bletchley for Ada Lovelace Day.

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19th Oct - GCSE and A-level Drama students visited the Noel Coward Theatre, London.

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


The trip was to analyse and evaluate the work of live theatre makers.



They saw the acclaimed stage adaption of The Ocean at the End of the Lane.


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13th Oct 2023 - MK Innovates Festival. This trip gave year 12 & 13 students an understanding of the different careers in STEM and business.






Year 9's took a trip to The National Space Centre in Leicester.


