DISCUSSIONS

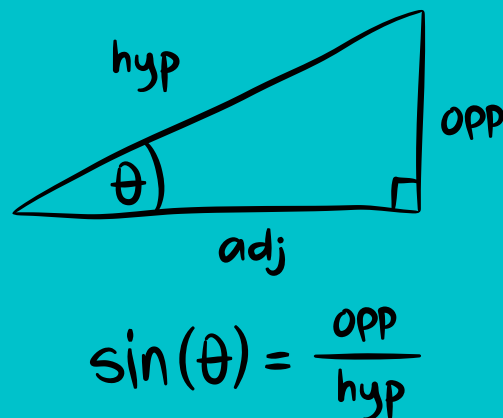
- Class discussions around different historical sources

- Key words - disciplinary literacy



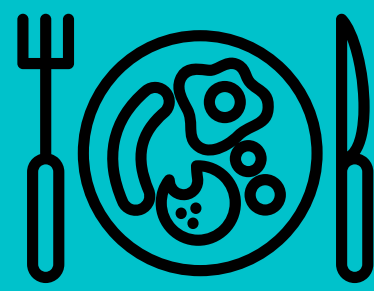
LINGUISTIC DIALOG
