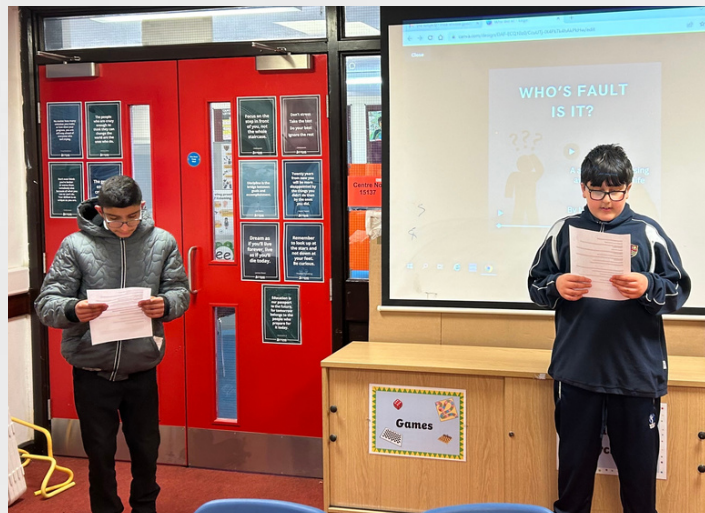
# Seated Volleyball

Some of our students were lucky enough to have the opportunity to play in a seated volley ball competition. They came in 5th place and received an award for determination.



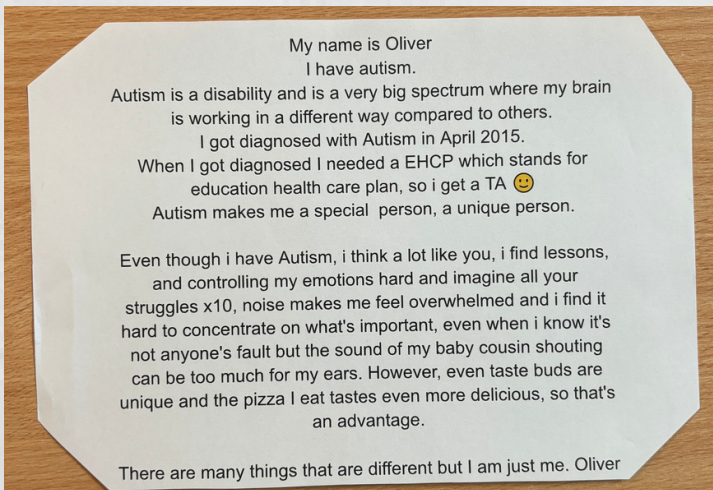
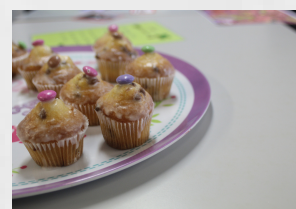
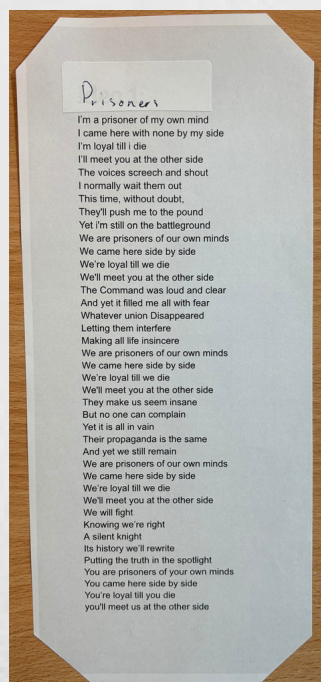
# Project Based Learning
